

AUXILIARY NURSING MIDWIFERY:

Auxiliary Nursing and Midwifery

Auxiliary nursing midwifery, is a two year nursing diploma program that teaches students how to provide basic health care and medical support to individuals, families, and communities.

DURATION

➤ Two Years (24 Months including 6 Months Internship)

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Candidates must have completed their class 12 and should have obtained the minimum qualifying marks from a recognized board.
- ➤ Candidates need to obtain at least 40% aggregate marks.

ANM ADMISSION PROCESS

- Visit the official website of the concerned institute or as per the desire of the candidate.
- On the website of the Nursing Schools, candidates can click on the registration tab available on the Home page.

GNM: GENERAL NURSING AND MIDWIFERY

DURATION:

➤ **Three Years** The diploma course in general nursing midwifery is three years including 6 months internship.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:-

Minimum Education:

- ➤ 10+2 class passed preferably Science (PCB) & English with aggregate of 40% marks.
- ➤ 10+2 in Arts (Mathematics, Biotechnology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Business Studies, Accountancy, Home Science, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy) and English Core/English Elective or Health care Science- Vocational stream only, passing out from recognized Board under AISSCE/ CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or other equivalent Board with 40% marks.
- ➤ 10+2 vocational ANM under CBSE Board or other equivalent board from the school and recognized by Indian Nursing Council with 40% marks.
- > Student shall be medically fit.
- ➤ Student qualified in 10+2 Arts or Science examination or Health care Science Vocational stream only conducted by National Institute of Open School with 40% marks Student shall be admitted once in a year.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:-

- Certificate of passing the qualifying examination
- ➤ Original mark sheet of H.S.C.
- > Original mark sheet of S.S.C./S.S.L.C
- Transfer Certificate or School Leaving Certificate, Migration certificate original
- Caste certificate issued by the competent authority, if admission is against reserved category
- Character/Conduct Certificate
- > Aadhar Card, Voter ID
- ➤ Certificate of change of name, if applicable supported by documentary evidence like government Gazette
- Gap certificate.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR STUDENTS

- ➤ **NATURE OF THE PROGRAM**: ANM is a full time regular program in nature. The classes will be conducted daily (from Monday to Saturday, 09.00 A.M. to 04.00 P.M.). Timings of clinical postings/field visits to Observation visits may vary from organization to organization and as per the time set by the organizations concern.
- > TRAINING METHODOLOGY: As per the guidelines of Delhi Nursing Council, the training will include theoretical sessions, practical lab sessions, clinical postings, field visits, observation visits, health camps, seminars and symposium etc.
- ➤ **STUDY MATERIAL**: All study material both in first and second year is against purchasing and available at the book counter of the school. Copy of the detailed syllabus as prescribed by Indian Nursing Council is available on payment of Rs. 100.
- ➤ **UNIFORM**: Students have to pay for their own uniforms. For practical hospital experience in the hospital ANM students wear Pink Checked Shirt and Blue Trouser with white apron. Length of apron is mid thigh with a collar and side pockets, with Black Close Shoes and white socks.
- ➤ CONDUCT OF THE STUDENT: Conduct of the students in their classes, as well as in premises of the School, Hostel and in the area, must be such as cause no disturbance to fellow students of the other classes. The students are not allowed to use alcohol, or to attend training classes under the influence of any type of intoxicants i.e. Tobacco, Barbiturates etc. in premises of the Hostel and the School.
- > CHANGE OF ADDRESS: Notice for change in address should be given by the candidate/student to the Office in writing immediately.
- ➤ DAMAGE TO PROPERTY: Students/Candidates shall do nothing either inside or outside the School that will in anyway interfere with its orderly administration and discipline. Non-compliance with the rules of the School, may be dealt with, by means of suitable fines and punishment.
- ➤ **MEDIUM OF EXAMINATION**: The Question Paper will be in English language. How ever, the examine will be at liberty to answer either in Hindi or English.



- ➤ **REFUND OF FEE**: Fees, once paid, is neither refundable nor adjustable in any circumstances, which may please be noted very clearly. The School will not be responsible for any change in circumstances or family economic condition or conflicts, disputes or decision to discontinue the study or any other reasons or in case, if a candidate is rusticated, from the School.
- ➤ LATE FEES/FINE: If the dues other than those payable at the time of admission are not paid by the due date, a late payment fine of Rs. 5/- for each day after the due date (including holidays) shall be realised subject to a maximum of Rs. 500/- only.
- TERMS OF PAYMENT: All fees are payable in advance and strictly either in Cash or through a Crossed Bank Draft made in favour of the 'Institute of Public Health & Hygiene', and payable at New Delhi' as per schedule.
- ➤ PAYMENT/REFUND OF FEES, FINES & DUES ETC.: Payment of course, Exam. Fee & other charges in time or on demand is the responsibility of the candidate, failing which, her name will be struck off from the rolls of the session without any notice and the fees paid by her will neither be refunded nor adjusted in any circumstances.
- ➤ **REFUND OF FEE**: Fees, once paid, is neither refundable nor adjustable in any circumstances, which may please be noted very clearly. The School will not be responsible for any change in circumstances or family economic condition or conflicts, disputes or decision to discontinue the study or any other reasons or in case, if a candidate is rusticated, from the School.
- ➤ PAYMENT OF DUES: All dues shall be cleared by the dates mentioned in the Prospectus/Office order etc. or as notified by the Management of IPH&HSCHOOL OF NURSING. Names of the candidates defaulting to pay the dues within 20 days will be struck off from the role of the IPH&H-SCHOOL OF NURSING.
- ➤ LATE FEES/FINE: If the dues other than those payable at the time of admission are not paid by the due date, a late payment fine of Rs. 5/- for each day after the due date (including holidays) shall be realised subject to a maximum of Rs. 500/- only.





- PAYMENT-FINE & DUES: Students shall have to pay on demand any fine imposed on her or the cost of any damage or loss of library books, equipments or other School's property movable or immovable

- > STRIKING OF THE ROLL/CANCELLATION OF THE ADMISSION: The name of the student may be struck-off from the rolls on account of:
 - 1) Her own request endorsed by her parents/guardian
 - 2) Continued absence without obtaining leave for Six (06) working days
 - 3) Irregular attendance and poor progress in studies;
 - 4) If her behaviour, character or activities are not satisfactory.
 - 5) If ordered to be expelled or rusticated from the School.
 - 6) Causing damage to the goodwill & prestige of the School.
 - 7)She has been found in a habit of consuming Alcohol/Barbiturates or any other sedatives and
 - 8)She is found indulged in any anti-social / illegal / criminal procedure of Law or any FIR has been lodged against her
 - 9) Found medically unfit to continue the program or having an epidemic of communicable nature during the course of study
 - 10)If any applicant who is offered admission does not report within the date specified on the notice of admission the offer will be treated as cancelled and the seat will be offered to the next eligible applicant from the merit list
 - 11)If Any Information/Certificate Supplied by the applicant in connection with her admission is later on, at any time, found to be incorrect or falsified it will result in cancellation of the admission of the student from the school

UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES, THE FEES WILL BE REFUNDED OR ADJUSTED AND DEGREE/ DIPLOMA/CERTIFICATE OF LESSER DURATION WILL BE ISSUED, IF ACANDIDATE IS RUSTICATED FROM THE SCHOOL.

➤ OTHER CHARGES: Every candidate shall have to pay/remit the following mandatory charges at the time of confirmation of her admission: (I) Uniform Charges: Approx Rs. 3,000/- or as applicable at the time of admission (ii) Books Charges: Approx Rs. 3,000/-per year or as applicable at the time of admission (iii) HIV/AIDS Conference participation fee - Rs. 1000/-(Approx.) Please Note: The Fee or above said charges if once paid, are neither refundable nor adjustable, in any circumstances.



- ➤ ACCOMMODATION IN THE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY: Students willing to opt for residential facility, shall have to fill-up the Application Form for reservation of Accommodation and at the time of admission only and submit the same to the School along with the residential charges, certificate of physical fitness duly signed by Medical Officer of the School. She shall have to live in the residential facility up to the Final Examination. She will not be allowed to leave the residential facility mid of the session. It is made clear to the Parents/Guardians that the School is not responsible for the undesired activities/leaving the School /Residential Premises without permission of the concerned authorities of the School/ Resident In-charge, any activities / habits of the students which may cause her any physical or mental trauma.
- ➤ FITNESS TEST: Nursing is physically demanding profession. Therefore, It is mandatory for Parents/Guardians to submit a medical fitness certificate from a medical officer having no less than MBBS degree. They also need to submit a declaration about the fitness of their ward. If there is any infection or disease that had occurred in past or present with the ward, it must be mentioned in a clear and detailed manner in the declaration to enable the School's Management to take precautions and proper care for the same.
- > CHARACTER & BEHAVIOUR OF THE CANDIDATE IN THE RESIDENTIAL FACILITY: The candidates shall have to maintain high standard of character, hygiene, social and mutual behaviour during their stay in the Hostel of School.
- ➤ RIGHT TO CALL PARENTS/GUARDIANS: The Secretary/Director/Principal of the IPH&H-SCHOOL OF NURSING are authorised and competent to call the parents/guardians of the students in the office of the IPH&H-SCHOOL OF NURSING or in its associated Organisations/Trust/Society/Hospital/ Nursing Homes in case:
 - 1) If the attendance of the student is less than 90% in any month
 - 2) If the student has developed a habit of keeping himself/herself absent from the classes without any intimation or permission;
 - 3) if her behaviour of action may cause/ has caused/ is causing damage to the movable or immovable property, prestige & reputation of the IPH&HSCHOOLOF NURSING and its Associated organisations,
 - 4) If her behaviour or character is not satisfactory or up to the mark
 - 5) If she has not paid the course Fees, Examination Fees, Hostel and Mess Charges.
 - 6) She has developed the habit of ignoring instructions issued by any authority of the IPH&H-SCHOOLOF NURSING, New Delhi. No. T.A./D.A. will be paid to the parents/guardians of the students, if called for meeting/ discussion.





- > FIELD PRACTICAL TRAINING: The students need to attend the clinical postings, seminars, observational field visits, internship/practical training etc. at their own conveyance/ expenses.
- > CHANGE OF PROGRAM IS NOT PERMISSIBLE: No Change of Program is permissible under any circumstances
- EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE: The School is also providing Employment Assistance to the candidates, who successfully qualify the ANM program. Candidates can apply on the Proforma available in the Office for registration of their name for Employment Assistance. But the IPH&H-SCHOOL OF NURSING, New Delhi does not guarantee or assure employment in any sector viz. Govt./Semi Govt./Private etc. in this context. Formation & Collaboration / joining of illegal Unions / Councils / Welfare / Associations of students are not allowed, and the candidates shall have to follow the high standard of moral and ethical values in life and practice during their stay, classes and training period in this School.
- The students are not allowed to indulge in any anti-social or any anti-religious activities and not to keep any arms and/or ammunition items during their stay and study in campus & hostel.
- Anti Ragging Policy: As per the directions by the Honourable Supreme Court of India, ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in educational institutions. In case, if any student is found ragging /harassing other candidate, she will be rusticated and booked under law.
